Pursuant to a contract with the Ministry of Education, Employment and Gender Affairs of the Cayman Islands Government, SCE's crews completed the environmental abatement and demolition of a portion of the John Gray High School in George Town, Grand Cayman, as the first phase of a project with a critical construction deadline later in the year.

Construction crews had to complete a new gymnasium that was to be featured in the Inaugural Cayman Islands Classic NCAA Basketball Tournament. With numerous collegiate and media participants depending on the completion of the venue in time for this major event, SCE's crew mobilized to the site, abated all asbestos, and demolished the facility ahead of schedule and without injury or incident.

The scope of work included the removal and proper disposal of 10,000 square feet of ACM floor tiles and adhesive, which then allowed for the demolition of the facility to make room for the new gymnasium complex.

SCE worked directly with the Government of Cayman on this effort.
