In northeastern Pennsylvania, SCE joined community partners and more than one hundred volunteers fighting against food insecurity. We provided staffing at Revolution Ice Centre in Pittston, PA for the Drive-Through COVID-19 Emergency Food Giveaway. This giveaway was open to the public, but food was provided to the first 500 participants. We were proud to host a successful event to help our community and neighbors through the challenges that COVID-19 sprung upon us.

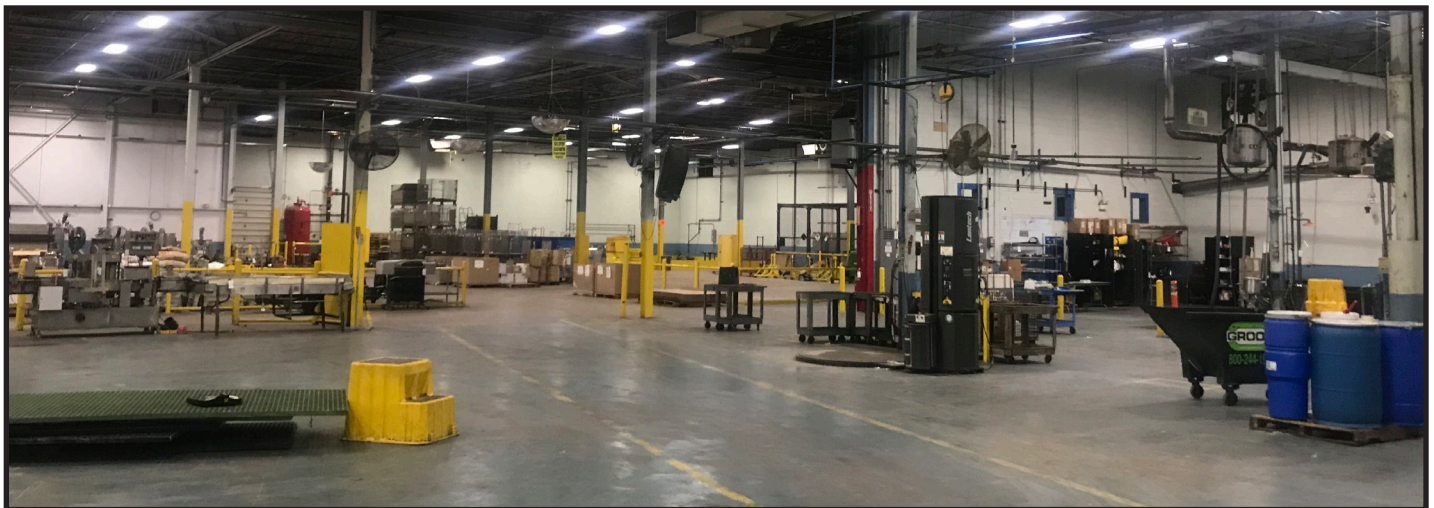


Industrial Services Project - Illinois.

SCE Environmental Group was contracted by a client to provide a full facility decontamination of a 150,000 square foot chemical/pharmaceutical plant in Illinois. The client is one of the leading firms in the United States that provides hazardous materials, waste transportation and disposal services. Our crews mobilized to the facility and worked closely with the Plant EHS manager.



SCE crews worked 12 hour days, 7 days a week. Crews worked hard on decontamination, draining, flushing and remediating plant equipment, including all process piping, duct work on the roof, ceilings, walls and floors throughout this plant. SCE decontaminated and cleaned several above and below ground vessels and dismantled heavy equipment throughout the facility. All the hazardous materials were segregated and containerized for safe transport and disposal. Our crews worked diligently to meet the needs of this contract to facilitate a large property transfer. SCE crews completed this project 2 weeks ahead of schedule to the complete satisfaction of our client.



Niagara Frontier Transportation Authority (NFTA).

SCE was contracted by the NFTA to provide weekly COVID-19 electrostatic decontamination and sanitization in all facilities in Buffalo, NY and Erie County. Our crews mobilized to decontaminate the airport operations facility, police headquarters, stations and fire headquarters. Our crews also decontaminated all of the emergency response vehicles. SCE crews worked closely with the agency chiefs and operations directors during their 24 hour a day 7 day a week schedule. All decontamination was performed to CDC and EPA guidelines and completed without any disruption to the delicate operations of the NFTA. Thank you commendations were sent to our SCE crews by the Police Department for keeping them COVID-19 safe. SCE is proud to keep these cities safe during a troubling time.



Second Quarter Highlights.

Lycoming County, PA.

SCE Environmental was awarded a contract to perform all COVID19 facility decontamination and Electrostatic Sanitization for polling locations in Lycoming County, Pennsylvania. There are up to 20 election polling locations throughout Lycoming County, PA. SCE crews performed the first phase of this contract in June 2020. Our crews mobilized off hours to enter all polling locations after the primary election.



This decontamination service gave facility owners and their visitors peace of mind that the buildings they entered were properly sanitized using methods approved by the CDC, EPA and local health departments. In November, SCE Environmental Group will return to Lycoming County to fulfill the final phase of this contract.

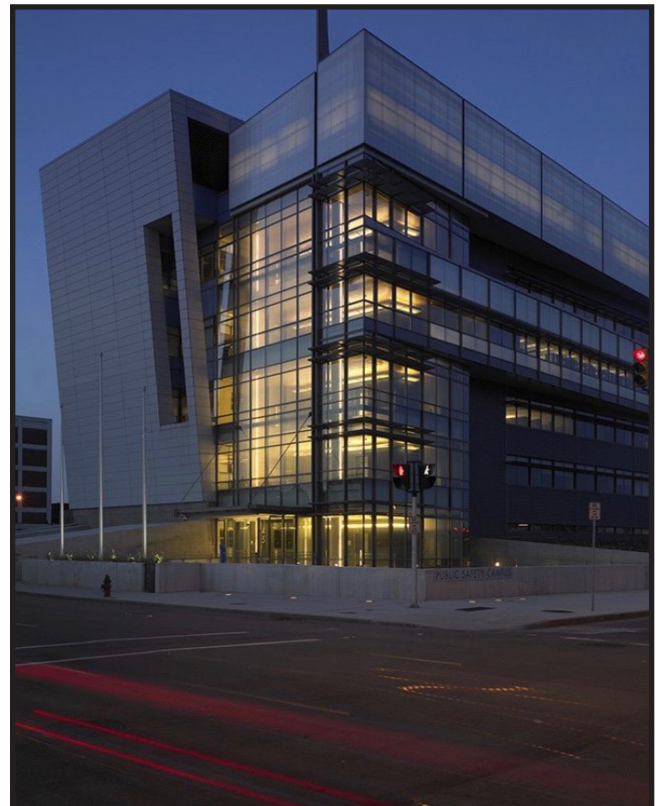
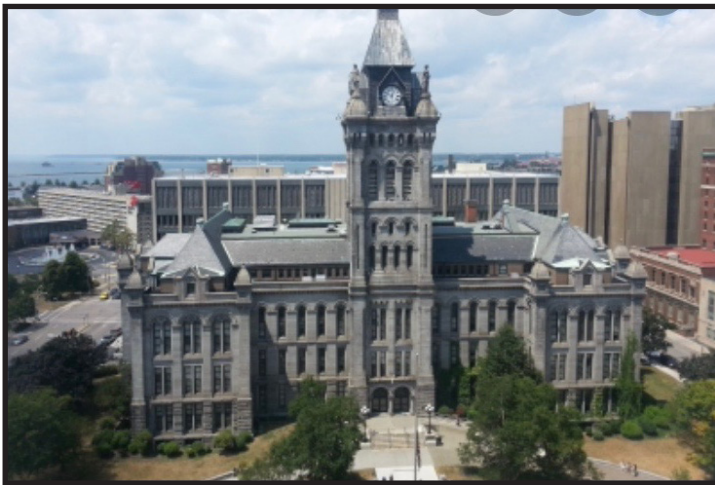
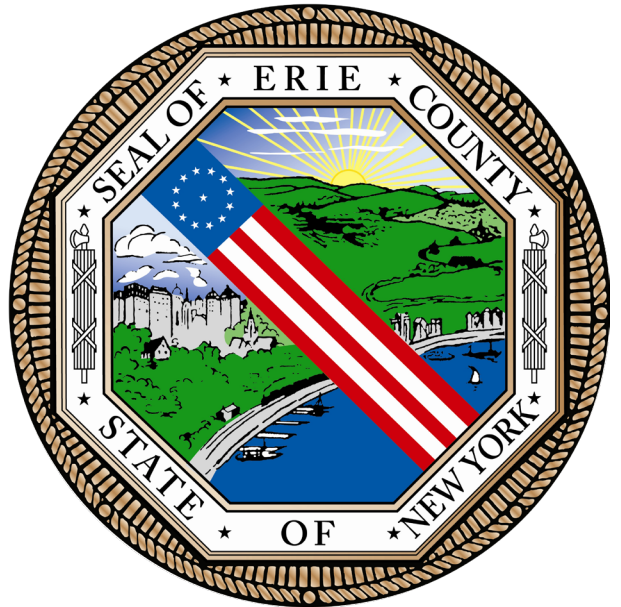
Carlisle Army Barracks - Carlisle, PA.

SCE was awarded a contract to perform general building and facility maintenance at the Carlisle Army barracks starting in June 2020.

Second Quarter Highlights.

Erie County, NY.

SCE Environmental Group was awarded a two-year emergency and disaster response contract with Erie County, New York. Erie County is home to over 1.3 million people and has over 50 cities, towns and villages. Our trained crews will respond to any environmental, or natural disaster we are called on for, including Covid19 decontamination, hazardous materials decontamination, tornadoes, floods, fire clean up and remediation. SCE will coordinate with the commissioner of disaster services of Erie County along with all department heads when a incident occurs.



Soil Excavation Project

Brooklyn, NY.

SCE Environmental Group was awarded a soil excavation contract in Brooklyn, NY. Project SOW includes remediation of PCB impacted hazardous soil and waste. This project also included site restoration and paving of excavated areas. SCE Environmental Group's crews implemented new fencing and drainage features, sheet piling and structural steel to rehabilitate and reinforce the old bulkhead system. This project took place along Newtown Creek in Brooklyn, NY.



EMR improved to 0.832.

Fleet-Wide Preventative Maintenance.

SCE Environmental Group took advantage of the COVID-19 slow down to perform preventative maintenance on all of our equipment. SCE spent over 2 months cleaning, painting, preventative maintenance and other necessary repairs that were needed in order for our equipment to be ready once the COVID-19 shut down was over. SCE painted all of our excavators, skid steers, dozers and all of our support equipment. The COVID-19 slow down allowed SCE to regroup and ensure all of our yellow iron equipment was ready to go back to work in a safe workable manner. In addition, SCE was able to re-evaluate our fleet so we could trade off any older equipment that wasn't needed or needed to be upgraded. SCE has already seen the results of our hard work as our utilization and uptime of our equipment has increased to over 80%.

Last Thoughts ...



Early this Quarter, I started a draft of this “Last Thoughts” letter for the First Quarter newsletter. In that draft, I talked of the wonderful progress we made in 2019 and the enviable position in which we found ourselves as the new year started. Our military housing renovation project, our largest in 2019, was about to enter a second year with the same potential to be our leading project. At the project in Brooklyn, our work with a major oil company awaited the arrival of spring to begin a new phase of the project. Our team was ready, the work was waiting, and the ground was thawing.

And then I blinked.

Whatever the first quarter may have been for the first 11 weeks, the last two will earn its place in history. Covid 19, changed everything. Not just in the microcosm of SCE, but for the entire world. Entire economies shut down, countries on lockdown, people self-quarantined and doing their best to avoid that hopeless panic that uncertainty like this can cause.

When a similar panic gripped the country on 9-1-1, SCE was there.
